The Wright Military Flyer

From slings and arrows, guns and rifles, to rockets and aircraft, there has always been a close link between technology and the military. Back in the day, one such aeronautical advancement was the application of the airplane to warfare. On 27 JUL 1909, Orville Wright successfully surpassed US Army requirements by piloting his Military Flyer for 1 hour, 12 minutes, and 40 seconds, a new world record. Signal Corps Specification No. 486 stated that in addition to staying aloft for at least 1 hour, the military flyer must also achieve a breakneck 40 mph, with an observer onboard, before the US Army would approve its bid price of \$25K. In fact, the Wright airplane was the only viable competitor, exceeding the speed requirement by 2 mph, earning Orville a \$5K bonus. Source: The Smithsonian
