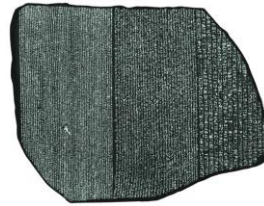

### MILITARY TRIVIA

#### ABC's (Military version)
