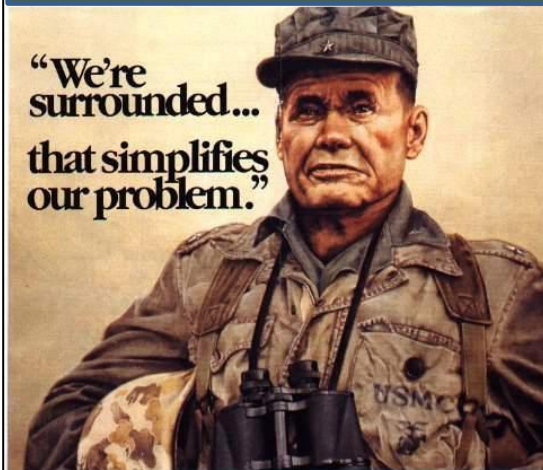
Counselor's Corner

CHESTY PULLER, LT. GENERAL, USMC (RET.)

Lewis Burwell "Chesty" Puller was a United States Marine Corps lieutenant general and one of the most decorated members of the Marine Corps. Puller is the only Marine and one of two US servicemen to ever be awarded five Navy Crosses. He fought guerrillas in Haiti and Nicaragua, and participated in battles of World War II and the Korean War. Puller retired from the Marine Corps with 37 years of service in 1955 and spent the remainder of his life living in Virginia.
