#### GENERAL COLIN POWELL, USA (RET)

General Powell, born in Harlem, began his military career in the Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) and served for 35 years. He saw two tours in Vietnam, served as National Security Advisor (while in the Army), and was appointed Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the only African-American to do so. After leaving the military, Powell became Secretary of State. Held in high esteem by both mainstream political parties, he was considered a potential candidate for President more than once. Powell is known for his Leadership Principles, one of which is, "Perpetual optimism is a force multiplier."
